Solve each problem. Answer as a mixed number (if possible).

Answers

1) $4\frac{1}{2} - 1\frac{1}{3} =$

$4\frac{3}{6} - 1\frac{2}{6} = 3\frac{1}{6}$

2) $4\frac{1}{4} + 2\frac{1}{2} =$

$4\frac{1}{4} + 2\frac{2}{4} = 6\frac{3}{4}$

3) $2\frac{1}{2} - 1\frac{2}{5} =$

$2\frac{5}{10} - 1\frac{4}{10} = 1\frac{1}{10}$

4) $5\frac{1}{4} + 1\frac{2}{3} =$

$5\frac{3}{12} + 1\frac{8}{12} = 6\frac{11}{12}$

5) $3\frac{2}{3} - 1\frac{2}{5} =$

$3\frac{10}{15} - 1\frac{6}{15} = 2\frac{4}{15}$

6) $5\frac{1}{2} + 1\frac{1}{3} =$

$5\frac{3}{6} + 1\frac{2}{6} = 6\frac{5}{6}$

7) $4\frac{1}{2} - 1\frac{1}{3} =$

$4\frac{3}{6} - 1\frac{2}{6} = 3\frac{1}{6}$

8) $4\frac{1}{2} + 3\frac{1}{5} =$

$4\frac{5}{10} + 3\frac{2}{10} = 7\frac{7}{10}$

9) $2\frac{1}{3} - 1\frac{4}{5} =$

$2\frac{5}{15} - 1\frac{12}{15} = \frac{8}{15}$

10) $4\frac{2}{3} + 1\frac{3}{4} =$

$4\frac{8}{12} + 1\frac{9}{12} = 6\frac{5}{12}$

11) $3\frac{4}{5} - 1\frac{1}{2} =$

$3\frac{8}{10} - 1\frac{5}{10} = 2\frac{3}{10}$

12) $2\frac{2}{3} + 1\frac{1}{5} =$

$2\frac{10}{15} + 1\frac{3}{15} = 3\frac{13}{15}$
