



## *Kidwatching Techniques* **Sticky Notes: Reading**

*Keep records for **all** students. Each week, focus on and record information for students in each developmental group. Information for every student will be recorded approximately once every week.*

### **Set Up Label Sheets**

1. Use mailing labels or nametag labels. Type or write each student's name and DRA2 level on each label.
