DISTANCE LEARNING MEAL DISTRIBUTION EXPANSION

Nutrition Services is expanding distance learning meal operations. Starting Tuesday, September 29, 2020, we will be adding three (3) additional meal pickup sites, to make for six (6) total distribution locations. This newest model – for students utilizing 100% distance learning – will provide pickup options three days each week, with morning and afternoon times each day. Through the data we've gathered, the below sites have been selected as pick up locations to provide services to students most in need. The updated meal pick up schedule is as follows:

TUESDAYS

12:00 pm–1:00 pm: North Valleys High School
3:00 pm–4:00 pm: Traner Middle School

WEDNESDAYS

9:00 am–10:00 am: Wooster High School
3:00 pm–4:00 pm: Clayton Middle School

THURSDAYS

10:00 am–11:00 am: Sparks High School
3:00 pm–4:00 pm: Pine Middle School

Regardless of site enrollment, families will have the option each week to pick up meals from the location that best meets their needs. Families requesting meals will need to sign-up each week through the online form.
