Ex) $\frac{3}{9} = \frac{6}{18}$

1) $\frac{3}{8} = \frac{24}{64}$

2) $\frac{2}{10} = \frac{6}{30}$

3) $\frac{2}{3} = \frac{12}{18}$

4) $\frac{5}{6} = \frac{40}{48}$

5) $\frac{1}{9} = \frac{6}{54}$

6) $\frac{2}{6} = \frac{20}{60}$

7) $\frac{1}{2} = \frac{2}{4}$

8) $\frac{1}{2} = \frac{8}{16}$

9) $\frac{1}{8} = \frac{4}{32}$

10) $\frac{2}{8} = \frac{4}{16}$

11) $\frac{1}{6} = \frac{7}{42}$

12) $\frac{3}{5} = \frac{27}{45}$

13) $\frac{4}{7} = \frac{32}{56}$

14) $\frac{4}{9} = \frac{16}{36}$

15) $\frac{4}{6} = \frac{24}{36}$

16) $\frac{7}{9} = \frac{49}{63}$

17) $\frac{1}{4} = \frac{2}{8}$

18) $\frac{1}{5} = \frac{8}{40}$

19) $\frac{6}{8} = \frac{48}{64}$

20) $\frac{4}{5} = \frac{28}{35}$
