

Free and Independent ACT Practice within Imagine Edgenuity

All current high school students will have an opportunity to self-enroll into free ACT practice courses. Students will see a grade; however, the intention is to prepare them for the ACT, so grades are not recorded. This opportunity is completely optional, and students self-enroll into a single or all strands for ACT practice at their own pace. Once enrolled, the courses may remain active for as long as the student needs. There is no obligation to complete a course once started.

How ACT Practice Courses Work

Every WCSD ACT Practice course contains both a diagnostic pretest and posttest. A diagnostic pretest evaluates a student's unique strengths and weaknesses. Based on the results of the diagnostic WCSD ACT Practice English: Production of Writing (8h 26m)

After completing their personalized learning path, a posttest is given to show mastery of the assigned skills from start to finish.
