2023-2024 SCHOOL PERFORMANCE PLAN



Student Success Goal

Students performing at or above grade level (level 3 and level 4) will increase overall by 5% moving from 55% to 60% in English Language Arts (ELA) and by 5% in Math moving from 54% to 59% as identified in 2024 Smarter Balanced Assessment (SBAC) data.

To support students to achieve this goal, we will:

1. Grade level staff engage in weekly Professional Learning Communities (PLC).
2. Grade level staff follow a three-week PLC cycle, Prepare, Analyze, Reflect.
3. Align Professional Development to PLC work (Teacher Clarity).
4. Administration attends all weekly PLC.
5. Administration supports PLC with interim assessment data.
6. Grade levels use current formative assessment data.
7. Learning intentions are clear to all students.
8. Student friendly rubrics and exemplars are consistently used.

Student, Staff, and Family Partnerships Goal

By December 2023, JWood Raw staff and students will have engaged in 30 Social Emotional Learning (SEL) Quaver Education lessons (approximately two lessons a week). By January of 2024, all stakeholders will receive a survey on our climate and SEL lessons and based on information received, by June of 2024, our schoolwide SEL program will be addressing student, staff, and family need and wants.

To support students and families to achieve this goal, we will:

1. Quaver Education lessons taught at minimum two times a week, morning meetings five days a week and optimistic closures five days a week.
2. Effective communication (weekly Connect Ed calls, newsletters, outreach, visibility).
3. Three town hall meetings.
