

Dear Brown Families,

School starts tomorrow for all of our Brown Elementary Students!

We are opening school during a pandemic. This means that we need everyone to be cognizant of what they are doing and where they are with lots of children in one area. No playground equipment will be utilized, there is no 'playtime' before school. If you are walking your students on campus, please stay 6 feet from other families and ensure everyone in your group is wearing their masks appropriately.

Back to Building Students:

- If you are coming back to the building. Please know that we will be out with vests on, you can find someone with a vest on and ask who your student's teacher is and where you need to take them.
- Teacher's will be out on their designated classroom lines or spot at 9:15am tomorrow morning, after tomorrow, all students will be taught to come immediately into the building at their designated wing door, and into their classroom. They will work at their desk until school begins.
- No parents are allowed inside the building. Please find a spot on the playground to meet your students daily if you plan to pick up and drop off on campus every day.
- If you want your "first day of school" picture by the sign, please make sure to social distance 6 feet from other families and take turns.
- Non-bus riding students should not be on campus before 9:15am, there will be no cross-walk duty personnel until 9:15am.

- I have attached the school rules again for your reference, I would really appreciate it if you would review these rules with your students. There are many changes to how school looks due to Covid 19, 6 feet apart, not sharing items, etc.
- There is now a crosswalk on the corner of Western Skies and Reading Way. This corner is very unsafe, there is a blindspot where if you are standing ready to cross on Reading you cannot see oncoming traffic and they can't see you. I would HIGHLY recommend you not park on Western Skies and try to cross there. Please park in our parking lot and use the safer crosswalks. Thank you.

For our Distance Learning Students:

- Your day will start virtually at 9:30am.
- You should receive information from your DL teacher regarding how your student will be learning daily.
- If you did not pick up the distance learning items for your students, you can come to the front office between 10am-2pm to pick up those items.

A couple of safety protocols to remember for On Campus Learning:

- **No parents, volunteers, extra adults will be allowed into the building at any time.**
- On the first day of school, you will find a location outside on the school grounds that will be your pick up/drop off spot if you are not using the Kiss/Drop area.
- Teachers will be out on their designated class lines on playground or front area the first day of school at **9:15am**.
 - Parents will not be allowed to 'drop off' students at the classroom, you will be able to drop them off at their designated class line outside.
- Only **ONE** adult in the single point of entry area/office at a time, please practice 6 feet social distancing and wait outside until the entry area is empty. Thank you for keeping all of our students and staff safe.
