



Parents must notify their child's school each day of an absence.

Absences from exclusions by the health district or school district due to Covid do not count towards chronic absenteeism.



Students are responsible for requesting make-up work from their teacher when they return from an absence. They have the number of days absent +1 from the day they receive the make-up work to complete it.



To exempt an absence, parents must provide documentation from a medical, mental, or behavioral professional.

Once this documentation has been provided, the absence will not count towards chronic absenteeism.



Students who are excluded from school due to Covid will be provided with a temporary distance learning plan. Each school has developed a temporary distance plan for its students.



Parents can monitor their student's attendance using the Infinite Campus Portal. For assistance setting up the parent Infinite Campus account, contact your student's school.

A student is identified as chronically absent when they miss 10% of school days or class periods. Chronic absenteeism can hinder a student's ability to read by the third-grade, to succeed in middle school, and to graduate from high school.
