Washoe County School District wants all student to have books in their homes before each school break to encourage reading and prevention of knowledge loss. Over the last 10 years, Volunteer Services has provided over 750,000 books for Home Libraries. These are *Give-Away* books for home libraries, designed to increase home literacy and encourage siblings to read to each other and parents to read to their children. We also provide books to community sites where our students might be like The Boys and Girls Club, women and homeless shelters, early-childhood centers, Foster Grandparents program, etc. This program is especially valuable for homeless families and homes where English is the second language and where there are no books.

To keep the book program alive, Volunteer Services needs highly skilled volunteers, who are willing to sort and prepare books for distribution to students with a goal of \$25,000 in funding for a part-time person to coordinate the book program.

At Volunteer Services, we also train volunteers and parents in Pre-K and elementary Reading, Writing and Math to prepare volunteers to help at school sites or to assist parents with information to better help their students at home.

WCSD averages 15K volunteers with about 3, 000 that are community volunteers tutoring our students or helping at school sites, departments and programs.
