/ SCHOLARSHIPS

/ FAFSA

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid:

Completing this application could qualify students for grants, loans, and work study opportunities. Federal financial aid is based on family economic situations and is on a first-come, first-serve basis. The 2025-2026 application is being released on/around December 1, 2024 by going to https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa.

Each student and at least one parent/guardian must create individual FSA IDs, which are used as electronic signatures, and are good for 10 years. FSA IDs can be created in advance of the FAFSA release date.

/ LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

Students must pick-up a questionnaire from their McQueen counselor and provide at least two weeks' notice.

/ HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPTS

These must be ordered from WCSD by going to https://washoeschoolsnv.scriborder.com/. The first four requests per school year are free of charge.

/ TRUCKEE MEADOWS

Admissions: The 2025-2026 application for admissions opens on September 1, 2024. Students must have the following to be considered:

- Be on track to graduate with a high school diploma
- Official high school transcript
- Immunization records

Promise Scholarship: Open to all Nevada residents who plan to enroll in a minimum of 12 semester credits in Fall 2025.
Application must be received by October 31, 2024.

<u>Success First:</u> Open to first generation college students.

/ UNIVERSITY OF NEVADA, RENO

Admissions: The 2025-2026 application for admissions is now open. Students must have the following to be considered:

- 3.0 weighted core academic GPA (English, math, science, and social studies). To calculate AGPA, go to https://www.unr.edu/prospective-students/agpa-calculator
- Official high school transcript
- Immunization records
- ACT or SAT score reports are optional, but are used for class placement and for institutional scholarship consideration (i.e., new scholarship matrix)
- FAFSA (completed by April 1, 2025)

Deadlines

- Early Action Application: November 15, 2024
- Regular Admissions Requirements Completed (to be considered for scholarships): February 1, 2025
- Final Admissions Deadline (without scholarship consideration): April 7, 2025

Nevada Bound Tours: This is a full day experience for prospective students and their families to visit UNR, learn about admissions, scholarships, financial aid, housing, and much more. / UNIVERSITY OF NEVADA, LAS VEGAS

Admissions: Students can be admitted with a 3.0 weighted core academic GPA, a 22 ACT composite, an 1120 total SAT score, or a Nevada Advanced Diploma.

/ UC OR CSU SCHOOLS

The application for the University of California (UC) system is now open. The application due date is November 30, 2024.

The California State University (CSU) application opens on October 1, 2024 and is due by December 2, 2024.

/ THE COMMON APPLICATION

Over 1,000 colleges and universities across the U.S. utilize The Common App. Complete one application to apply to multiple schools (Examples: UNR and UNLV). Must list McQueen Counselor as part of the application process.

/ TEST OPTIONAL?

Many colleges and universities are now "test optional" schools, which means that submitting a qualifying ACT or SAT test score is not required. It is a student responsibility to check with their college(s) of choice to determine if test scores are required.

If a qualifying test score is required, students should consider taking the December 2023 test administrations of the ACT or SAT to earn the score they need for admissions and/or institutional scholarship opportunities (e.g., for UNR).

/ NCAA ELIGIBILITY CENTER

Eligibility: Students who wish to be considered for collegiate athletics at the Division I, II, or III level, must be approved through the NCAA Eligibility Center. Students are advised to check on eligibility standards and requirements, and then follow these steps:

- Apply online and pay the required fee at https://web3.ncaa.org/ecwr3/. The McQueen school code is 290143
- Complete the required amateurism acknowledgement form
- Send an official high school transcript
- Send an SAT or ACT score report (this must be initiated through College Board or ACT; McQueen cannot send these)

/ MILITARY SERVICE

ASVAB: Students interested in joining a branch of the U.S. military should consider taking the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery, which is offered twice per year at McQueen. See Ms. Kirk in the College & Career Center, room 503, to sign-up.
