## **Beginning Band Grading Procedures**

\*Band grades will be determined using the grading categories below.

#### **ASSESSMENTS** (30% of overall grade)

- <u>Pass-off tests:</u> There will be several of these assigned each quarter. The goal of these tests is to pass with 100% accuracy as they will cover the basic building blocks of musicianship. Students may take them as many times as they would like until the end of the quarter and if they are unable to pass with 100%, I will enter the grade the highest grade they earn.
- Written assessments: These will be given to show knowledge of music reading, symbols and terms.
  - Students will always be given notification and will only be tested on concepts covered in class. If students practice regularly, they will not have a problem with any of the tests.

#### **PARTICIPATION** (50% of overall grade)

Your participation is graded according to your preparedness and active participation in class. You may receive up to 20 points per class session. To be considered prepared for band, you need to bring the following items to every band class:

- Instrument: 10 points
- All music (Band book, concert music, or other handouts): 5 points
- Planner, pencil, instrument accessories (reeds, oil, etc.): 5 points
- \*Participation points will also be subtracted if you are off task or disrupting the class.

#### **CONCERT ATTENDANCE** (20% of overall grade)

The band has two concerts this year. **Student attendance at these events is mandatory.** A student's grade will be lowered two full letters if they miss a concert. If a student must miss a concert, they must submit a signed parent note with a valid excuse to Mr. Skinner either two weeks before the concert for prearranged absences or within one week after the concert for unexpected absences (sickness, family emergencies, etc.) An alternate assignment will be given for excused absences. If families can avoid scheduling elective surgeries/procedures before concerts (especially dental), please do! See the band calendar so you can ensure your attendance at all concerts this year.

#### **CITIZENSHIP** (Behavior)

Students will receive 100% at the start of each quarter. For each negative behavior event, a student will lose 5 or more points. If there are outstanding positive behavior events, a student will receive up to 5 points.

#### LATE WORK/ABSENT POLICY

- See planner for the Late Work Policy (pg. 12)
- If absent, a student's participation grade will be lowered because they were not at school to participate in class. Students will need to practice for 20 minutes in order to raise their participation grade. They can do this before or after school or at lunch, upon Mr. Skinner availability. If they make this up at home, parents must send an email to Mr. Skinner confirming they practiced. Their participation grade will be raised once the student has practiced.

#### TAKING INSTRUMENTS HOME

- Students are expected to take instruments home every weekend and over fall, winter, and spring break.
- This encourages students to practice their skills at home to continue their growth.
- This is also to give students the time to prepare for Pass-off test

#### **Discipline Plan**

#### THREE STRIKE SYSTEM

- **First Strike:** Warning
- Second Strike: Student Packs Up Instrument
- **Third Strike:** Alternative seating and alternative assignment. The incident will also be recorded in Infinite Campus as a Behavior Minor.

## Supplies - 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Band

Every student is responsible for having the following supplies for sixth grade band class:

- 1. **Instrument**  $6^{th}$  grade students pick from the instruments below. Students wanting to play percussion must play a wind instrument during  $6^{th}$  grade before transitioning to  $7^{th}$  grade.
- 2. **Band Book** Will be provided to student from Class Fee.
- 3. Class Fee \$20 beginning band fee is for a Band T-Shirt, Band Book, and Classroom Supplies.
- *4.* **Band Folder** (*This will be provided along with other band music*)
- 5. **Pencil** Keep in instrument case as we ABSOLUTELY use them daily.
- 6. **Portable music Stand** (*Optional for at home practice*)
- 7. **Instrument Accessories** Students renting instruments from Shaw\* will receive all of the following accessories. Students renting from outside sources will have to provide their own supplies. The supplies are as follows:

<sup>\*</sup>Shaw is unable to rent any Saxophone to beginning students. If students wish to play this instrument, they must provide their own.

\*\*Only 1 bassoon or oboe reed will be provided to the student. I suggest contacting local Bassoonist/Oboist for more reeds. Contact Mr. Skinner for their information.

#### **Band Instrument Rental**

For Beginning Band Students

#### **Rental/Purchase Options:**

- **Rent-to-own from a local music store** (*or online*). Approximate Prices: \$30-45/month for flute, clarinet, trumpet and trombone. Saxes and larger instrument are around \$50-80/month.
- Purchase from a local music store or online (*I do not recommend this option for beginners*). If you are going to purchase, I will be happy to give input about instrument quality and price.
  - Remember, you get what you pay for! No quality band instrument will be less than \$200.
- **Rent instrument from the school.** Rental fees are \$50 for the school year (<u>Limited inventory</u>- Students may not get their first choice instrument). \*There will **not** be any school Saxophones available to 6th graders.

#### **Rental Procedures:**

- From Music Stores: Families review prices from different stores and then go in to rent/buy.
- **For School instruments**: Students will notify Mr. Skinner if they need to rent an instrument from the school. If there are enough instruments, Mr. Skinner will send home a rental contract. The inventory will be available on a first come, first served basis. Students will not receive school instruments until Mr. Skinner have received contract and payment. The fee for renting a school instrument is \$50 for the year. Any questions, please contact Mr. Skinner.
