Intermediate & Advanced Band Grading Procedures

*Band grades will be determined using the grading categories below.

ASSESSMENTS (30% of overall grade)

- <u>Playing Assignments</u>: These will be done randomly throughout each quarter. Students will be notified at least one week ahead of the assignment and will be tested during class time.
 - Students are encouraged to take their instrument home to practice in order to prepare for the playing assignment.
- Written assessments: These may be given to show knowledge of music reading, symbols, and terms.
 - You will always be given ample notification and will only be tested on concepts that have been covered in class. If you are practicing regularly, you will not have a problem with any of the tests.

PARTICIPATION (50% of overall grade)

Your participation is graded according to your preparedness and active participation in class. You may receive up to 20 points per class session. If a student is absent, they will <u>not</u> receive credit for the class. *Please see Late Work/Absent Policy below.* To be considered prepared, students must bring the following items to every band class:

- Instrument: 10 points
- All music (Band book, concert music, or other handouts): 5 points
- Planner, pencil, instrument accessories (reeds, oil, etc.): 5 points

RHEARSAL & PERFORMANCE ATTENDANCE (20% of overall grade)

The band will have several after-school rehearsals and performances during the year. **Student attendance at these events is mandatory.** A student's grade will be lowered two full letters if they miss a concert. If a student must miss a concert, they must submit a signed parent note with a valid excuse to Mr. Skinner either two weeks before the concert for prearranged absences or within one week after the concert for unexpected absences (sickness, family emergencies, etc.) An alternate assignment will be given for excused absences. If families can avoid scheduling elective surgeries/procedures before concerts (especially dental), please do! See the band calendar so you can ensure your attendance at all concerts this year.

CITIZENSHIP (Behavior)

Students will receive 100% at the start of each quarter. For each negative behavior event, a student will lose 5 or more points. If there are outstanding positive behavior events, a student will receive up to 5 points.

LATE WORK/ABSENT POLICY

- See planner for the Late Work Policy (pg. 12)
- If absent, a student's participation grade will be lowered because they were not at school to participate in class. Students will need to practice for 20 minutes in order to raise their participation grade. They can do this before or after school, upon Mr. Skinner availability. If they make this up at home, a parent/guardian must send an email to Mr. Skinner confirming they practiced. Their participation grade will be raised once the student has practiced and Mr. Skinner has been notified.
- Students may also complete practice logs to make up participation points.

TAKING INSTRUMENTS HOME

- Students are expected to take instruments home every weekend and over fall, winter, and spring break.
- This encourages students to practice their skills at home to continue their growth.

BAND PRACTICE LOG (Quarterly Challenge/Absence Make Up)

Students may complete an optional weekly home practice log this year.

- Practice logs are due every Monday WITH A PARENT/GUARDIAN SIGNATURE.
- Students who complete 100 boxes of practice will receive a pizza party each quarter.
- Practice logs will be checked each class for completion. If a student did not practice the previous night, they will not be able to claim the boxes later.
- 5 Complete boxes will also be accepted for missing class but will be subtracted from the pizza party total.
- If a student is caught lying, they will lose all points towards the pizza party and will not be able to use practice logs to make up any absence.

^{*}Participation points will be subtracted if you are off task or disrupting the class.

Supplies – Intermediate & Advanced Band

Every student is responsible for providing the following supplies for their grade band class:

- 1. Instrument
- 2. **Band Book** This will be provided to all band students and is included in their class fee.
- 3. **Band Folder** (*This will be provided along with other band music*)
- 4. Class Fee The fee for this class of \$30 for Band Polo, Travel Fees, and Classroom Supplies.
- 5. **Pencil** Keep in instrument case or near music as we use them <u>daily</u>.
- 6. **Instrument Accessories** Students renting instruments from Shaw MS* will receive all of the following accessories. Students renting from outside sources must provide their own supplies. The supplies are as follows:

^{*}Shaw MS is unable to rent any alto saxophone to students. If students wish to play this instrument, they must provide their own.

Band Instrument Rental

Rental/Purchase Options:

- **Rent-to-own from a local music store** (*or online*). Approximate Prices: \$30-45/month for flute, clarinet, trumpet and trombone. Saxes and larger instrument are around \$50-80/month.
- **Purchase from a local music store or online** (*do not recommend this option for beginners*). If you are going to purchase, I would be happy to give input about instrument quality and price.
- **Rent instrument from the school**. Rental costs \$50 for the school year.

Rental Procedures:

- From Music Stores: Families review prices from different stores and then go in to rent/buy.
- For School instruments: Students will notify Mr. Skinner if they need to rent an instrument from the school. If there are enough instruments, Mr. Skinner will send home a rental contract. The inventory will be available on a first come, first served basis. Students will not receive school instruments until Mr. Skinner have received contract and payment. The fee for renting a school instrument is \$50 for the year. Any questions, please contact Mr. Skinner.

Intermediate & Advanced Band Concert Uniform

We will wear our uniform at all concerts. Intermediate & Advanced Band uniforms include:

- Your band polo (included in band fee, will be given out prior to our first concert)
- Solid **BLACK** pants (*Dress pants preferred*, but nice solid black jeans would be acceptable)
- Solid **BLACK** socks, dress shoes, and belt (*Belt not required if not needed*)

^{**}Saxophone students must provide their own neck strap

^{***}Only 1 bassoon or oboe reed will be provided to the student. I suggest contacting a local bassoonist/oboist for more reeds. Contact Mr. Skinner for their information.

Discipline Plan

THREE STRIKE SYSTEM

• First Strike: Warning

• **Second Strike:** Student packs up instrument

• **Third Strike:** Alternative seating and alternative assignment. The incident will also be recorded in Infinite Campus as a Behavior Minor.
