- Local government or community involvement

- Drafting legislation

Requirements:

- Student must be a high school senior planning to attend an accredited 4-year college
- Student must have a GPA of 3.5 or higher
- Student must submit a 500-750 word essay on “How my Law-Related Education and Activities Inspire Me”
- Student must complete the online application, submit a copy of their latest transcript, a copy of their academic resume, copies of their SAT/ACT scores and at least 2 letters of recommendation
- Student must be a US citizen
