We reviewed our assessment data to create <u>our school performance plan</u> for this school year. Last year 40% of Clayton Students were proficient or higher on the ELA Smarter Balanced assessment. This was the same level of proficiency as the previous year. Last year 27% of Clayton Students were proficient or higher on the Math assessment. This was 2% higher than the previous year.
