## iReady Middle of the Year Diagnostic Coming Soon

It is time for our students to show us the progress they have made this school year. The Middle of the Year (MOY) iReady Diagnostic test will help us understand how your child's hard work has translated into academic gains this year. Students will complete the Reading portion of the diagnostic starting December 4th and the Math portion starting on December 11th. We encourage students to try their best and show what they know on the tests, not only to celebrate their learning, but to plan for their second semester schedule. Students scoring below grade level are assigned an extra support class. If students improve their scores, they may be switched out of an extra support class for one of our enrichment courses.

# Clayton Data Point

In each of our Cub Community News editions, we will include a data point from our school. It could be related to our general demographics, student achievement and assessment, school programs and services or school goals.



iReady provides us a lot of information student progress. The diagnostic windows are the points of the school year that offer us the most information because we can compare student scores during the same school year. After the upcoming Middle of the School Year (MOY) diagnostic, we will be able to tell student progress toward annual goals and stretch goals as well as students' projected proficiency on our Smarter Balanced Assessments (SBA; state test) that students take in the fourth quarter.

This is how students scored on our Beginning of the Year (BOY) diagnostic:

## Reading:

- Mid or Above Grade Level = 17%
  - Early On Grade Level = 14%
- One Grade Level Below = 18%
- Two Grade Levels Below = 13%
- Three or More Grade Levels Below = 38%

#### Math:

- Mid or Above Grade Level = 7%
  - Early On Grade Level = 14%
- One Grade Level Below = 29%
- Two Grade Levels Below = 15%
- Three or More Grade Levels Below = 34%
