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DESCRIPTION

Damonte Ranch High School is a comprehensive four-year high school, founded in 2003, with a current fall 2018 enrollment of 1800 students with a senior class of 425 students. When DRHS opened its doors it was unique in that it was the only school in the district with a 7-12 grade enrollment. In 2008, we transitioned back to a traditional 9-12 grade high school. The student body is diverse with 58% white, 28% Hispanic, 6% Asian, 6% Multiracial, and 2% African American.

COMMUNITY

The Washoe County School District is the second largest school district in Nevada with approximately 64,000 students enrolled in 93 schools. Reno is a city located in the northwestern part of the state. The Washoe County School District (WCSD) is focused on creating an education system where all students achieve academic success, develop personal and civic responsibility, and achieve career and college readiness for the 21st century.

CURRICULUM FEATURES

- **Block Schedule:** DRHS functions on a rotating block schedule, with three 95 minute academic classes every day, followed by a 45 minute Instructional Center at the end of each day.
- Instructional Center (IC): The purpose of IC is to teach and support students in the use of structured independence to reach individual, school and district learning goals. Students will be self-directed and take responsibility for themselves to pursue higher standards of learning, through flexible academic and intervention time.
- Freshman and Sophomore Seminar: A required 9th and 10th grade course designed to help transition freshmen students into the high school setting and to develop within each student the positive self-discipline, self-learning, and self-advocacy skills which will transfer to their future years in instructional center and academic settings. This course utilizes Social and Emotional Learning Curriculum to accomplish its goals.

PERFORMING ARTS CENTER (PAC)

PAC is currently the only performing arts Signature Academy in the Washoe County School District, providing advanced education and training in Orchestra, Band, Choir, Drama, and Dance. Upon completion of the program, utilizing extended day elective courses in the performing arts, students will earn a PAC diploma.

ADVANCED COURSES

Damonte Ranch High School offers comprehensive academics, including 21 Advanced Placement and 12 honors courses. These **AP** courses are offered: Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Environmental Science, Calculus AB and BC, Probability and Statistics, English Language and Composition, English Literature and Composition, Psychology, European History, US History, Government and Politics, French, Spanish, Computer Science, Art, and Music Theory.

GRADING

- A= 90.0-100, B= 80.0-89.99, C= 70.0-79.99, D= 60.069.99, F= 0-59.99.
- Unweighted Cumulative GPAs are determined on a whole grade system (4.0=A, 3.0=B, 2.0=C, 1.0=D, 0.0=F).

WEIGHTING

- For weighted GPAs: Honors classes will be weighted by .025 and AP classes will receive a .050 weight.
- Transcript GPAs: All student transcripts show both a cumulative unweighted GPA and a cumulative weighted GPA.

• Class ranking for seniors is recalculated for each semester of high school course

work and is calculated using a weighted GPA.
