High school seniors need to complete the Nevada Promise Program Training by March 1, and all Nevada Promise involved students need to complete the 2024-2025 FAFSA by April 1.

If you, or someone you know, would like to help guide teenagers as they exit high school and enter their young adulthood, [please apply to be a volunteer mentor](#). The time commitment is minimal: about 1 hour per student per semester for a meeting and outreach once a month or so to check in with your mentees. We will assign students to mentors after they meet the May 1 deadline for eight hours of community service.
