Nevada Promise Scholarship

Nevada Promise candidates have just passed the March 1 deadline for completing a program training. Students must now ensure they complete their 2024-25 FAFSA by April 1 to remain eligible.

We are still very short on new mentors this year. If you or someone you know is interested in mentoring students as they transition into young adulthood and college life, please have them [apply to be a Nevada Promise mentor](#). Mentors must be at least 21 years old, pass a confidential criminal history report, and complete a training session. The time commitment is minimal, no more than 3-5 hours a semester.

TRIO Student Support Services (SSS) Program Fees

Do you know about **TMCC's TRIO Student Support Services Program?** TRIO SSS is a federally funded access and retention program through the U.S. Department of Education aimed at increasing the persistence and graduation rates of low-income students, first-generation students, and students with disabilities.

New Student Orientation

All new-incoming degree seeking students have access to New Student Orientation in their [TMCC Canvas](#) account. Until completion, there will be an Orientation Hold on the students account.

They will need their TMCC username and password that was provided to them in their admissions letter when having applied to the College. If they need assistance logging in, please see the online student authentication tools at selfservice.tmcc.edu. They can also call our Welcome Center for help locating or resetting that as well at 775-673-7111.

New Student Orientation provides information on the catalog, English and Math placement, how to enroll, what classes to take for their first semester and preparation for their first semester.

After completing the modules and submitting the orientation's final step, the enrollment hold on their MyTMCC account will be removed within three business days. During open registration, you will also have the option to attend an in-person Registration workshop to receive hands-on registration assistance. (Open workshops will be available beginning in June)

High School Registration Workshops

TMCC Recruiters have planned with each high school's Career Techs at least 1 or 2 dates where we are offering Registration Workshops at your respective high school. The Recruitment and Access Center will send a team to meet at your school to help students with Fall registration. These will begin mid-April and continue throughout May.
