Success First Summer Bridge

TMCC's [Success First Program](#) is a first-year college program designed to help first-time college students achieve academic and personal success. Encourage your students to apply to the Summer Bridge program to be eligible for two FREE entry level college classes (Math and EPY/College Success Workshop), FREE supplies, mentorship and an \$800 scholarship.

Summer & Fall High School CNA Classes at TMCC

Nurse Assistants are needed in our community, and they earn competitive wages. For students interested in becoming Nursing Assistants, TMCC offers classes for high school students. Early Childhood Education Certificates

Scholarships are available for students who wish to complete the Early Childhood Educator 1 and/or 2 Skills Certificates. Scholarships cover all tuition, fees and textbook costs for the required classes. Interested students should email ece@tmcc.edu.

Business FastTrack

Students interested in participating in the [Business FastTrack degree program](#) this year can complete prerequisites this summer and start the program in the fall completing their entire Business degree in five week class blocks with either a one year or two year completion plan.

Nevada Promise Scholarship

The original date for the 2024-25 FAFSA deadline for [Nevada Promise](#) scholars and candidates has been moved to May 1, which is the same deadline we have for completion and submission of eight hours of community service. This will give students more time to complete the 2024-25 FAFSA if they are unable to complete it due to a known problem, such as having parents without SSNs.

We have begun assigning mentors to students if the students are still eligible and have completed the above requirements. We need just a few more mentors to meet the demand for this year. [Apply to be a mentor here](#). If you've been waiting for a sign to do something new and unique, here it is!

Men of Color Mentorship Program

Our Men of Color Mentorship application is available year round! We aim to support young men from underrepresented backgrounds in retention and graduation rates in high school, and college, through targeted support and interventions. Please refer applicable students to our program! Students from Sophomore year to Senior year are encouraged to apply at moc.tmcc.edu.

New Student Orientation

All new students must complete mandatory [New Student Orientation](#). Orientation covers catalog information, placement tests, enrollment, first-semester classes, and general preparation for being a new student.

Upon completion, the new student orientation hold will be removed from their mytmcc account within 3 business days. To login, students will need their TMCC username and password from their admissions letter. For login help, use selfservice.tmcc.edu or call 775-673-7111.

Registration for new students starts on April 18th. They can self-enroll online with help throughout the orientation or attend in-person workshops starting in June.

TRIO Student Support Services (SSS) Program Fees

FAFSA Updates

Corrections cannot be made until the form shows as Processed under the activity section of the student's studentaid.gov account.

Schools are still awaiting the delivery of FAFSA information. Students will get an email to their TMCC assigned email address to notify them once we have received their FAFSA information.

- An additional email will be sent if documents are needed for file completion or verification.

The Priority Deadline to have all documents submitted for file completion or verification is July 1st.

- Students can still turn in documents after this date, however their aid may be delayed.
