THE FEROAH COLLEGE AND CAREER CENTER: Stop by the Feroah College and Career Center (CCC) and see Ms. Ortiz for college and career guidance. **All Feroah Center updates are included in the Sunday emails from Mr. Hackbusch.** All events and campus visits are listed on the website calendar so get in the habit of regularly checking it. In the Feroah CCC you can find:

UNR: Admission to UNR will require:

- a **3.0 GPA** (weighted) in the **core** academic classes (4 English, 3 mathematics, 3 science, and 3 social science).
- For students not meeting the GPA requirement, test scores may be submitted. An SAT combined math and reading/writing score of 1120 or an ACT composite of 22 and the required academic core are also eligible for admission.

NEVADA BOUND- A free program available for prospective students and parents to visit the UNR campus.

- Learn about admissions, scholarships, financial aid, housing, tour all the residence halls, meet with academic representatives, and participate in informal discussions with current students and faculty.
- We strongly encourage JUNIORS to attend in the **spring of their Junior year**. Register at www.unr.edu/visit

PSAT: If you take this test in October when you get your results, you will have:

- **Free access** to personalized SAT Practice through the Khan Academy as well as career, college, and major information through a program called Big Future
- Create an account through College Board at psat.org/myscore (this account **will be used** for all SAT and AP info too!)

ACT IS REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION: All juniors will take the ACT at RHS on **March 1st, 2022**. Participation is required for graduation. **This is a site administered exam (not National) so you do not register or pay for it.** **Please note** that when you take the ACT on March 1st you will be asked to provide an email and your score report will be sent to this email address. The score report will include an **ACT ID number that you need to access and/or send your scores.** You will need this ACT ID to register for a National Test Date

ACT/SAT - Most colleges/universities are not requiring the ACT and/or SAT for admissions, but many are using the scores for math and English placement. It is recommended you take both the SAT and ACT in the spring of your junior year. Registration is available online. **See reverse side for 2021-2022 National Test Dates.**

TMCC DUAL CREDIT CLASSES: TMCC offers dual credit/jump start classes for high school students to earn both high school and college credit. Information on how to enroll can be found on the RHS counseling website or <https://www.tmcc.edu/jump-start-program>.

MILLENNIUM SCHOLARSHIP: If you are on track for an Advanced Diploma and will have been a resident of NV for at least two years by the time you graduate, you will also qualify for the Millennium Scholarship which provides up to \$10,000 for eligible institution of higher education in Nevada (UNR, UNLV, TMCC, WNC, etc.)

MINIMUM LOAD REQUIREMENT FOR SENIORS: Registration for senior year classes will be in February. If a student is on track for graduation, in order to have a minimum load of only 5 classes your senior year, there is a set of criteria that must be followed. Students must be:

- On track for an Advanced Diploma with a 3.0 GPA and having 19 credits going into senior year (the state is possibly going to raise it to a 3.25 GPA) OR
- On track for the College Career Diploma (CCR) with 3 math and 2 science earned; and 1 math and 1 science scheduled

NCAA ELIGIBILITY CENTER Students must be approved through the NCAA ELIGIBILITY CENTER if you plan to play sports at a Division I or II University. Check for Eligibility Standards and Requirements

- Apply online at www.eligibilitycenter.org and Pay the required fee
- You must complete the required amateurism acknowledgement form
- You must order an official transcript at www.washoeschools.net/renohs (Quick Links: Transcript Request) to be sent to the eligibility center to complete your application. **Your first 4 transcripts are free.**
 - This should be done **after** grades are posted at the end of 6th semester in late June
- You must send 1 official SAT or ACT score directly to the NCAA from the testing centers
