How do I apply for one of the Enterprise Project signature academy pathways?

Starting November 15th, complete the online application at washoeschools.net/sacte. The first deadline is January 15th. If there are vacant seats in our programs after the first round, there will be subsequent opportunities to apply.

Can I apply to the Enterprise Project Academy if I am not zoned for Reed? If so, how does transportation work?

Yes! We reserve up to 25% of our openings for non-zoned students. Non-zoned students are granted a Signature Academy variance upon acceptance. Unfortunately, we are not able to provide transportation for students from outside of our zone. Visit washoeschools.net/sacte for information about variances and high school sports.

If accepted, how do the academy classes work in my school schedule?

For the most part, academy classes fulfill the elective requirements for graduation. For information about diploma requirements in WCSO, visit <https://www.washoeschools.net/Page/3301>.

If I have to take Enterprise Project academy classes, can I take other electives (band, orchestra, choir, etc.), too?

Yes, but there are still limitations as there are only 7 periods in our school day. Students who wish to participate in multiple programs may have to take courses outside of the traditional calendar/school day to meet the academy and graduation requirements. Once accepted, students can work with the academy counselor to come up with a 4-year academic plan.

What if I'm interested in the classes, but not the academy?

We welcome any student to sign up for academy classes. However, priority placement is given to academy students so placement for non-academy students in academy classes is not guaranteed. Please note, our Biomedical program is almost always full of academy students so non-academy students are rarely able to enroll. For this reason, we strongly encourage any interested student to apply.

What if I get into the academy, but decide I no longer want to participate?

We ask students to commit to one year at a time. Students who are no longer interested in the academy can withdraw during the course selection process that takes place each spring.

Can I apply to the academy after starting high school?

In some cases, yes. Applications for current Reed 9th and 10th grade students are available each school year for students currently enrolled in academy electives. The Biomedical pathway, however, is usually full so it is rare that any current students are given the opportunity to apply.
