Students must complete the 24 credit requirements above for an Advanced Diploma and demonstrate the following:

1. Proficiency in speaking not less than 2 languages (Seal of Biliteracy) or have earned not less than 2 credits in any combination of the following:
 - a. Advanced Placement courses; or
 - b. International Baccalaureate courses; or
 - c. Dual credit courses or courses completed through dual enrollment; or
 - d. Career and technical education courses; or
 - e. Work-based learning (internships); or
 - f. A world language course
 - g. A world language course
2. Plus, earn one or both endorsements:
 - a. College Ready Endorsement
 - i. English: 18 ACT English or SAT Reading 480; and
 - ii. Math: 22 ACT Math or SAT Math 530.
 - b. Career Ready Endorsement
 - i. Score of 50+ or higher on the ASVAB; or
 - ii. Score of Silver or higher on the NCRC; or
 - iii. Be a completer of a CTE program of study and earn the Nevada Skills Certificate; or
 - iv. Obtain an industry recognized credential on OWINN list (Nevada Industry-Recognized Credential).

Eight credits must be designated with a bump; and

No course failure during the last two years, unless the course is repeated to remove the "F" from the transcript. U is not considered for this purpose.

Plus:

1. Plus, earn one or both endorsements:

a. College Ready Endorsement

i. English: 18 ACT English or SAT Reading 480; and

ii. Math: 22 ACT Math or SAT Math 530.

b. Career Ready Endorsement

i. Score of 50+ or higher on the ASVAB; or

ii. Score of Silver or higher on the NCRC; or

iii. Be a completer of a CTE program of study and earn the Nevada Skills Certificate; or

iv. Obtain an industry recognized credential on OWINN list (Nevada Industry-Recognized Credential)
